TRAVEL POLICY

- Our travel policy previously stated that team members who travelled internationally, on a cruise ship, or on a river boat needed to notify their leadership team and quarantine for 14 days. This policy has been expanded to include potential quarantine for domestic travel, too; if team members travel to a place designated as a “red” location on the CDC’s “Cases in the Last 7 Days” tracker on this link here - <https://www.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/index.html> - they will be asked to stay home for 14 days.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

- The check-in process has been updated to not only ask about symptoms, but will also include questions on exposure through caregiving, *close contact, or travel.
- *Close contact includes: Lived or stayed overnight with you, stayed within six feet of you for more than 10 minutes while not wearing a mask, or exposed you to direct contact to bodily fluids.
